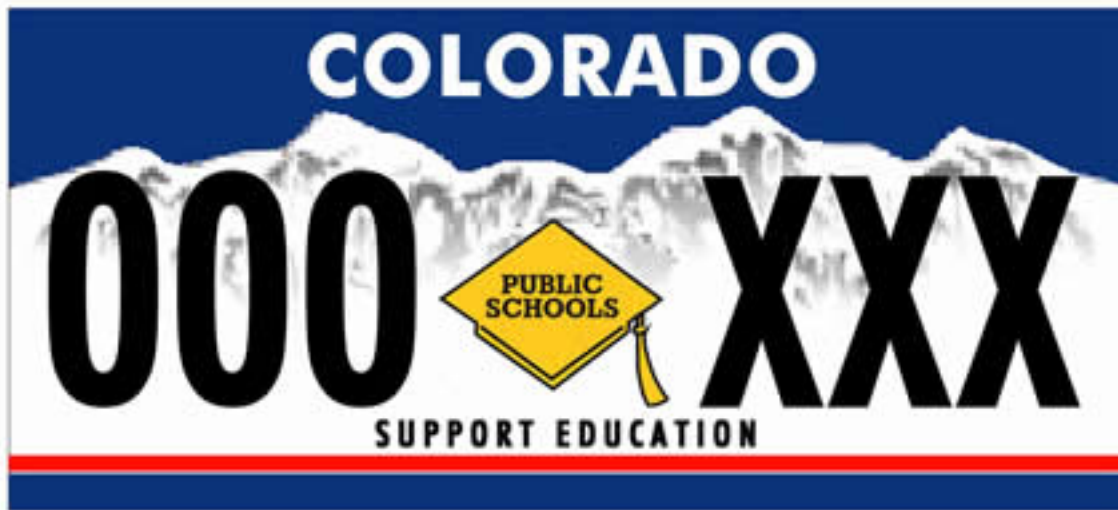

Specialty License Plates Available January 1, 2007

The Clear Creek Education Foundation, Inc. is pleased to support a statewide license plate campaign to raise funds for public education. On May 26, 2006, Governor Owens signed house bill 06-1404 which made official the creation of a special license plate to support programs that focus on student learning in Colorado public schools. All Colorado residents who make a minimum \$20 donation to Impact on Education, Inc. will be eligible to purchase the specialty license plates. Impact on Education will issue a certificate of approval confirming the donation has been received and will disperse the donations to local education foundations, such as the Clear Creek Education Foundation, Inc.

In order to receive the Support Public Education specialty license plate from the county motor vehicle office, an individual must present the certificate, pay a \$50 special interest plate fee required by the state, and pay any other registration taxes and fees. The plates are available now.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: Where do I send my donation?

A: Your \$20 minimum donation can be contributed online at www.SupportColoradoSchools.org

Please specify that the donation goes to the Clear Creek Education Foundation, Inc.

Q: What will the Support Public Education specialty license plate cost me?

A: **Year 1 Total Cost = \$70** plus vehicle registration fees and taxes, this includes:

\$20 donation to Impact on Education

\$50 special interest plate fee required by the state

Normal vehicle registration taxes & fees

Year 2 and Beyond Cost = Normal vehicle registration taxes & fees

Individuals are not required to make an annual donation to keep the license plates.

Q: Are applications and donations being accepted now?

A: Yes, please feel free to submit your application along with your donation at anytime.

Q: What percentage of my donation will go to Clear Creek Education Foundation, Inc.?

A: 100% of donations collected will go directly to Clear Creek Education Foundation, Inc. Just designate the Clear Creek Education Foundation, Inc. as the recipient of your donation on the application form.

Q: Is my donation Tax Deductible?

A: Yes, Impact on Education will provide a receipt to file with your taxes.

Q: When can I pick up my Support Public Education Specialty license plates?

A: Your Certificate of Approval will be emailed to you for print out – bring it with you to the County Motor Vehicle office. Support Public Education license plates are available now at your Colorado County Motor Vehicle office.

Q: My Vehicle Registration is not due in January, can I still get the plates?

A: Yes, you may donate during the year and purchase the plates anytime after January 1, 2007.
